This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of
regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.24 dated 10.01.2016 registered
under Sections 148,149, 285,323,427,506, IPC and Section 25, 54, 59 of

Arms Act in which Section 302 was added. at Police Station- Sadar Palwal,

District Palwal.

On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:

“These are petitions for grant of regular bail to the petitioners.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the three petitioners involved in the present cases have not attributed the injury caused to the deceased person but have caused simple injuries to some of the witnesses and as a matter of fact the family members of the deceased have turned hostile.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant states that the complainant has been examined and his cross-examination is fixed for 4.8.2016.

In the circumstances, it would be appropriate to conclude the cross-examination before considering the prayer for bail.

Adjourned to 8.8.2016.

A photocopy of the order be placed on file of connected case.”

It has been stated that the complainant has been cross-examined yesterday.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has
been in custody since 11.01.2016.

Learned Deputy Advocate General has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the
case and keeping in view the period of custody, I deem it appropriate to
release the petitioner on regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
