This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 20.11.2013 (Annexure P-9) passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh in a complaint case No.15331 dated 17.03.2011, whereby the request of petitioner to stay the proceedings in complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and to club the same along with a criminal case arising out of FIR No.82 dated 11.04.2013, under Section 420 I.P.C., has been declined.

Learned counsel for the respondent informs that the proceedings against the petitioner under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act have reached the final stage after recording of evidence and that the said proceedings are now pending at Panchkula in Haryana whereas the investigation of the FIR is being undertaken in Chandigarh.

In view of the stage of the different proceedings, no ground is made out for clubbing the proceedings in a State case with a private

complaint. The reliance on provisions of Section 210 Cr.P.C. is absolutely misconceived.

No ground is made out for clubbing or interfering in the order dated 20.11.2013 (Annexure P-9).

The present petition appears to be an attempt by the petitioner who is accused in a private complaint as well as in a State case, to delay the proceedings.

Dismissed.
