This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr. P.C. Seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 6 to protect the lives, liberty and properties of the petitioners as well as his family members at the hands of respondents No. 7 to 12, who are in connivance with each other harassing the petitioner and his family members by putting pressure upon them to withdraw a criminal complaint filed by the against respondents No. 7 to 12 pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ferozpur.

Instant petition is lingering on since 2014 and a perusal of file reveals that petitioner is not interested to pursue this matter as in most of the dates fixed in the case none has opted to appear. Today, Mr. Harpal Singh,

Advocate has come present but he is not aware about the facts of the case.

Finding no justification, instant petition is dismissed.

However, petitioner shall be at liberty to approach respondent No. 4 by moving a representation within a period of 7 days, which shall be dealt with and disposed of by respondent No. 4 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and if some substance is found in the allegations levelled in the representation, respondent No. 4 is also directed to take an appropriate action in accordance with law.
