The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.131 dated 20.06.2016 registered under Sections 406 & 506 IPC at Police Station City Narwana, District Jind.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposed the petition for grant of anticipatory bail.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 11.07.2016. There is observation in the interim order that an amount of ₹7.90 lacs have been paid back.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bijender Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 11.07.2016 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.

The complainant is at liberty to take such steps available under law for recovery of money.
