AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to ensure the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel states that in this connection he has also moved a representation (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.2 and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required to take whatever action he

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deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
