The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.371, dated 26.12.2014, registered under Sections 302/201 of the IPC, at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from HC Saravjeet Singh, states that all the witnesses have been examined, which fact has been disputed by counsel for the petitioner who states that three witnesses still remain to be examined and the matter is now fixed for

31.08.2016.

Counsel for the respondent states that without getting into this controversy at this stage, it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial and the prosecution undertakes to lead the entire evidence on 30.9.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Keeping in view the statement of counsel for the respondent, I dismiss this petition at this stage but direct the trial Court to release the petitioner on bail in case the prosecution fails to conclude the evidence on or before 30.09.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
