The petitioners claim that they have entered into matrimonial bond which is not acceptable to respondent No.4, father of petitioner No.2 as petitioner No.1 is a divorcee.

The petitioners appear to have filed a representation to Superintendent of Police, Amritsar vide Annexure P-5.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur Athwal, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioners will not be forcibly taken into custody by the respondents on the allegations that petitioner No.1 has married to petitioner No.2 against the wishes of petitioner No.4 or that the matrimonial bond of the petitioners is contrary to the wishes of respondent No.4 or any other person. In case of any violation of right of personal liberty, it will be open to the petitioners to approach the concerned police official of the area in District Amritsar where the petitioners are residing.
