This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.255 dated 01.08.2015 registered under Sections 136 of E.C. Act at Police Station City Pundri District Kaithal.

As per FIR, the allegations against the petitioner are that he used to purchase transformer parts and copper wires etc. from his accomplices, who used to steal them and then sold them to somebody in U.P.

Custody certificate filed by Superintendent Jail, District Jail, Kaithal filed in Court today is taken on record, according to which, the petitioner is involved in 82 cases of similar nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, points out that the petitioner has not been convicted in any case and is in custody since 24.08.2015.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny him the concession of bail.

Learned State counsel, however, points out that in view of the pendency of so many cases, there is likelihood that the petitioner would abscond in the case since the petitioner has got bail in every case.

Bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kaithal who would ensure adequate security to deter the petitioner from absconding.

Petition stands disposed of.
