This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.39 dated 05.06.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, Bathinda, under Section 420 read with Section 34 IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Ms. Shivali, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present FIR has been registered by name against the present petitioner and other co-accused/non-petitioners.

The FIR was registered after some preliminary inquiry and no evidence

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against the present petitioner was found.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 12.07.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is now not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 12.07.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
