AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.744, dated 08.06.2016 registered under Sections 148/149/324/354/379-B/452 and 506 IPC (Sections 354 IPC and 379-B deleted lateron) at Police Station Panipat City, District Panipat.

As per the allegations Vicky son of the petitioner was quarrelling with a third person and when the complainant intervened he was first slapped and then he alongwith his brother and 5-6 other boys barged into his house and gave him injuries. The allegations are that they had taken Rs.33,000/- and gold of 40 grams and had also misbehaved with the wife and mother of the complainant and also gave beatings to them though the allegations under Section 354 IPC and 379-B were deleted lateron.

The officer has accepted that there is no attribution to the present petitioner and that both the sons of the present petitioner have been arrested.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 27.07.2016 and on any other date as and when his presence is required. On his appearance the I.O. shall release him on bail to his satisfaction subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. In case the petitioner does not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
