The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.176 dated 28.11.2013, under Sections 279, 304-A, 427 IPC, PS Model Town, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 26.9.2016, report of the learned JMIC, Hoshiarpur has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.
