There is no purpose for consideration of the case for an appeal for compensation where there is nothing brought on record to show the basis for awarding compensation. The Tribunal has declined the claim on the ground that neither the injured claimant nor the doctor was examined to prove the nature of injuries. The court was justified in dismissing it and I find no reason for interference. The appeal is dismissed.
