This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.247 dated 16.06.2016 registered under Sections 420, 415, 120-B IPC and 15(2), 15(3) of Indian Medical Council Act and 3A, 6(c), 23 of Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulations and Prevention of Misuse) Act 1994 at P.S. Civil Line, Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states at best that the case is of an attempt and maximum punishment prescribed is 3 years.

Learned Addl. A.G., Haryana on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh has accepted this fact.

In this circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case I do not deem it appropriate to dismiss the petition. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 22.08.2016 or any other date as and when his presence is required. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he will be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
