**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Allegations against the petitioner Pranav Grover in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.201 dated 20.04.2016 registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar under Sections 304-A/285/201 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, are that on 18.04.2016 at a marriage celebration due to freak accident has resulted in the death of a young girl Aniya.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 25.04.2016 and that the parties have already effected a compromise, have certainly not been refuted by learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer, ASI Rakesh Kumar, Police Station City Yamuna Nagar as well as counsel

representing the complainant Mr. Anshul Mangla, Advocate, and the complainant Sandeep Sharma, who has been identified by his counsel as well as by the Investigating Officer, has testified before this Court that since he has entered into a compromise he has no objection if the prayer made in this petition is allowed.

Taking into consideration the compromise and the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is unwarranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
