AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner has sought direction to the official respondents to initiate an appropriate legal action against the private respondents No.4 & 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this

connection he has also moved a representation dated 12.09.2014

(Annexure P-4) which has been addressed to the DGP, Punjab and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner move a representation to the respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. The respondent No.2- the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
