Main Case

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in
case FIR No.0029 dated 26.02.2016, registered under Sections 419, 420,
465, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the Act'), at
Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.

Custody certificate has been filed in the Court, is taken on

record.

It is contended that in the present case complainant-Sukhdev Singh, Security Officer, Guru Nanak Dev University had lodged the present FIR on the basis of complaints received from Amarjit Singh and Lovepreet Singh. He stated that it was a loan transaction and the same stands settled. In this regard, affidavits of Amarjit Singh and mother of Lovepreet Singh, namely, Paramjit Kaur as Lovepreet Singh has gone abroad, have been furnished.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, informs that the petitioner is involved in other FIR, registered under Sections 379 and 411 IPC.

Heard.

In view of the compromise effected between the petitioner and said Amarjit Singh and Lovepreet Singh, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
