AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of secondary examination certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 05.09.1993 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of voter card (Annexure P-2) depicting his age as 20 years as on 01.10.2014. They have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Hisar

(Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Superintendent of Police, Hisar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexures P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
