The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of Som Nath, who has allegedly been duped by the petitioner and others with a promise that the son of complainant, Jaswinder Singh, will be sent to Australia against a fake Visa after having been called to Delhi.

Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose the petition for bail contending that the petitioner has played an active role by introducing the complainant to Dalbir Singh, Mohan Lal and others and the money was paid in his presence. The co-accused of the petitioner seem to have not been arrested.

Since the petitioner himself is not the actual beneficiary of the wrongful loss caused to the complainant and he has joined investigation, he can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that he will facilitate the investigation by helping the investigating agency to arrive at a just conclusion and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.
