JASPAL SINGH, J.

Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.894, dated 09.10.2015, under Section 120-B, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated October 26, 2016, report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise is a genuine one and arrived at amicably between the parties. Even otherwise, the matter involved is

soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances and in view of the pronouncement captioned as “**Kulwinder Singh & others v. State of Punjab & others; 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.894, dated 09.10.2015, under Section 120-B, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
