AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondents No.5 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of his Aadhar card (Annexure P-1) wherein his year of birth is mentioned as 1998 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of her Aadhar card (Annexure P-2) depicting her year of birth as 1998. They have also moved a representation before the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala (Annexure P-7) for protection of

their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexures P-7).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
