The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 251 dated 14.10.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 307/326/325/324/323/341/506/148/149 of IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

The report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence. Learned counsel for the complainant stated that he has no objection in quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurwinder Singh has stated that in this case the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC

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has been deleted and now offence punishable under Section 326 IPC regarding injury on the index finger is there.

It is an injury case. Since, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, FIR No. 251 dated 14.10.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 307/326/325/324/323/341/506/148/149 of IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar stand quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed.
