Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner Biram in case FIR No.633 dated 23.11.2015 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 353, 186 and 307 IPC as well as Section 3 of the Public Property Prevention of Damage Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh.

Earlier, the petitioner had filed CRM-M-43323 of 2015 for the similar relief, but the same was dismissed as not pressed by this Court vide order dated 21.12.2015.

Perusal of the FIR in question shows that there are specific

allegations levelled against the petitioner and SI Rohtas Kumar has sustained grievous injuries on his head and got 25 stitches in the incident, as revealed from the medico-legal case summary. Therefore, no case for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
