JASPAL SINGH, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the instant petition on behalf of petitioner No.13- Karanjit son of Sh. Darshan Singh.

In view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.13-Karanjit son of Sh. Darshan Singh.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 59, dated 11.06.2015, under Sections 365, 452, 323, 324, 342, 148, 149 of

IPC, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise dated June 20, 2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. In compliance of order dated December 01, 2015, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Nakodar, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with their free will, without any pressure or coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 59, dated 11.06.2015, under Sections 365, 452, 323, 324, 342, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners No.1 to 12 & 14.
