Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.81 dated 25.7.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpura, District Roopnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 13.7.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Harbans Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that as informed by the IO, the talks for compromise are in progress.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 13.7.2016 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
