Pursuant to interim order dated 21.07.2016, the petitioner has already put in appearance before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose application for bail saying that there are serious allegations against the petitioner.

The allegations and the evidence against the petitioner would be required to be scrutinized at the time of final stage of the trial but till date the petitioner does not appear to have misused his liberty and dual version regarding his involvement has already cropped up on the basis of investigation conducted as he was not challaned having been found innocent.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner will remain on bail against the bail bonds already furnished by him pursuant to interim order dated 21.07.2016 passed by this Court subject to the

conditions that he will continue to appear before the trial Court and will not in any manner hamper the trial and will not directly or indirectly threaten the witnesses.
