Allegations against the petitioner Karamjeet Singh in this anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. are that on 21.05.2016 complainant Raghbir Singh posted as ETO in Mobile Wing, Patiala had tried to forcibly stop a truck bearing registration No.UP-15CT-3930 carrying iron pipes and in the ensuing a scuffle took place where gunman of the ETO is alleged to have fired hitting the tyre of the truck and bursting the tyre.

Contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that neither complainant was on duty in the area nor has any role to stop the truck and that the entire story is mere concoction as he wanted to overtake the truck driver illegally thus a road rage and that no injury has been caused to the complainant, nullifies the allegations. Though on behalf of the

State bail is opposed on the grounds that the petitioner is sought to take law in his hands.

Appreciating the submissions of the two sides, the petitioner as is contended by his counsel, happens to be owner of the goods which were being ferried and no role is attributed to the petitioner and has been subsequently named for extraneous reasons and being a non-injury case and that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner, impels this Court to allow the prayer made.

The petitioner shall put in appearance before the Investigating Officer within seven days from today and on his doing so he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
