INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.251 dated 21.08.2015, registered at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala Cantt. Haryana, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Rajiv Kumar Saini, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant and contested this petition.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version,

Dheeraj Sehgal got a receipt in his favour by impersonating Vidya Sagar and Kamla Devi wife of Vidya Sagar by showing that entire consideration has been paid regarding the property in dispute. During the investigation, the said receipt has been found to be forged as the same has been admittedly executed after the death of Vidya Sagar. The allegation against the petitioner is that he signed the said document in the name of Vidya Sagar. On the basis of said document, Dheeraj Sehgal entered into an agreement to sell with the complainant and others and cheated the complainant party.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
