This is a petition u/s 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner FIR No. 80 dated 12.05.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323,324, 34 IPC (Section 307 added later on, 25/54/59 of Arms Act) registered at Police Station E-Division, Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that actually the dispute is with the father of the complainant and the rest of the family members have

been roped in just to create pressure. The main accused i.e. father of the petitioner has surrendered.

Learned Addl. A.G., on instruction from ASI Sukhdev Singh accepts this fact.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 03.08.2016 or any other date as and when her presence is required. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, she will be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
