Petitioner seeks the benefit of anticipatory bail under Section 438 read with Section 482 of Cr. P. C in Criminal Complaint No.100/1/10 dated 21.07.2010 (New No.66/15), under Sections 323, 341, 506 of IPC and read with Section 3 & 4 of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act filed by respondent No.2.

Service of complainant could not be effected as he is stated to abroad.
