Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.352 dated 25.6.2016, under Sections 21-B/27-A/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City, Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. He was neither arrested from the spot nor recovery was effected from him. He has been illegally roped in the present case as well as other cases. The recovery effected from the petitioner is non-commercial.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar has submitted that as many as 8 cases are registered

against the petitioner and out of these cases, 7 cases are registered under the NDPS Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Taking into consideration the allegations levelled against the petitioner coupled with the fact that besides this case, he is accused in as many as 7 other cases, therefore, a habitual offender, it cannot be presumed that the cases registered against the petitioner are planted one. Therefore, this Court does not find any merit in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
