Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 to 5 to take action in view of the order dated 20.11.2016 passed by this Court and upheld by Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dated 01.07.2013.

2. Notice of motion to the respondents.

3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Copy of the paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though legal notice dated 24.05.2016 (Annexure P-10) has been served upon the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar as well as Station House Officer, Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar but no substantive action has been taken. Only the

Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar has forwarded the said legal notice to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar as the matter relates to the area which falls within his jurisdiction but even thereafter, no action has been taken in the matter.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 24.05.2016 (Annexure P-10) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
