Petitioner was arrested on 22.03.2016 along with 20 vials of Rexcof. On receipt of report of Forensic Science Laboratory in September, 2016, the contents were found to be Codine Phosphate. It has been informed that no prosecution witness has been examined.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to make an earnest endeavour to conclude the trial within a period of three months after the next date of hearing. Since petitioner has remained in custody with effect from 22.03.2016, without any witness having been examined, it is ordered that in case all the prosecution witnesses are not examined within the above said period, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
