Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members.

Record reveals that FIR No.31 dated 18.6.2016 under Sections 324, 323, 341 and 342 read with Section 34 IPC has been registered against the family members of petitioners at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner and her family members are being given threat by Didar Singh and

Balwinder Singh, the complainant in the FIR and to that effect, the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 18.6.2016 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Sultan Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law.
