Petitioner Kamil has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.501 dated 14.05.2016, registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat, District Panipat under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the petition.

Police record is also available.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the perusal of the record, I find that as per the allegations of the prosecution, 350 grams of Charas has been recovered from the petitioner. Admittedly, the same falls under the non-commercial quantity.

The present petitioner is in custody since 15.05.2016. He is no more required for any investigation or custodial interrogation. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the disposal of the case.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the merits of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 35,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
