ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.288 dated 12.10.2015, registered under Sections 304, 313, 314, 315 IPC and Section 23 of PNDT Act (challan filed under Sections 304, 313, 314, 315, 420, 201, 120-B IPC, Section 22 of NDPS Act, Section 15(2)(3) IMC Act and Section 3, 4, 5 of MTP Act and charge framed against the petitioner under Section 120-B, 304, 313 and 201 IPC), Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 12.10.2015 and out of 29 witnesses 17 PWs have been examined and the allegations against the petitioner are that he took the girl for her abortion to Soni Hospital. The counsel says that the main witnesses have been examined and the doctor who is alleged to have done the procedure was allowed bail. The counsel says that the complainant and Tulsi have not supported the prosecution version.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial is taking time, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
