Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.20 dated 30.1.2014 under sections 420, 447, 452, 380, 506, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, City Gurdaspur.

During the course of arguments it has gone uncontroverted that in so far as petitioner no.2 namely Manju wife of Sanjeev Gill is concerned, the order granting interim relief was made absolute by this Court on 10.3.2015.

As far as petitioner no.1 Sanjeev Gill is concerned, this Court on 26.5.2015 had noticed that he has surrendered before the court and as such the present petition seeking concession of pre-arrest bail stands rendered infructuous.

No further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.
