Vide this common order above mentioned two petitions are
being disposed of as they arise from the same FIR.

In FIR No.19 dated 15.03.2009 registered under Sections
326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station
City South Moga, District Moga, the petitioners are the accused persons.
Admittedly, the challan has been filed. Mr. Sandeep Sharma, Advocate
for the complainant states that now there is a compromise arrived at

between the parties to these petitions. I have perused the FIR and find that there was a free fight in which some persons were injured. Even otherwise, the offences are under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of IPC. With the intervention of the respectable persons parties have decided to compound/compromise the offences in question. I think, there is no point in continuing the prosecution against the parties and they do not want to prosecute further and have arrived at compromise in order to live in peace and harmony. The petitioners be allowed to compound/compromise the offences in the FIR.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:-

1. Both these petitions are allowed.
2. FIR No.19 dated 15.03.2009 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising there from qua petitioners only.
