By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners have sought pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.64, dated 22.04.2016, under Sections 160, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 3(x) of SC and ST Act, 1989 added later on, Police Station C Division, Amritsar.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel that after the registration of FIR for the commission of aforesaid offences, offence under Section 323 IPC has also been added. However, learned State counsel was kind enough to state, on instructions, from ASI Gurshaib Singh, Police Station C Division, Amritsar that petitioners have already joined the investigation on 22.07.2016 and they are no more required for further interrogation.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid aspects of the case but without

expressing any opinion on the merits, the petition is allowed and order dated 14.07.2016 is made absolute but subject to the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

4. Here, it is made clear that the petitioners shall be released on bail under Section 323 IPC in addition to the other offences find mentioned in the FIR in question.
