Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 for registration of a case against private respondents No.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.3 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar is directed to take note of the representation dated 29.12.2015 (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.

On the asking of this Court, Ms. Shaveta Sanghi, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Let requisite number of copies of complete sets of the paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 29.12.2015 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law.
