JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Raj Kumar, seeking regular bail, during the pendency of the trial, in case bearing FIR No.10 dated 06.01.2016, under Sections 406, 420, 506 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Indri, District Karnal.

It is an undisputed fact that the petitioner was arrested in this case on March 18, 2016, subjected to custodial interrogation, then sent to judicial custody. After completion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the Court of jurisdictional Magistrate, the disposal of which is likely to take sufficient long time. In the given circumstances, it would not be desired to keep the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
