Reply to the petition has been filed by learned State counsel,
which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Through instant petition moved under Section 482 Cr.P.C.,
petitioner has sought direction to the official respondents to register FIR
under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC and to investigate the
matter in fair matter.

A perusal of preliminary objections taken by the State of UT,
reveals that FIR No. 249, dated 16.06.2014, under Sections 420 and 120-B
IPC has been registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh and both
the accused namely Sanjay Kumar Sharma and Rajneesh Kaushal have
been arrested and challan has already been presented against them in
court on 22.07.2015.

So, in view of the aforesaid facts, instant petition has rendered
infructuous and the same is therefore, dismissed as such.
