JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Jagmeet Singh @ Jagveen Singh @ Meena, seeking regular bail, during the pendency of the trial, in case bearing FIR No.0022 dated 14.03.2016, under Sections 307, 336, 334 of Indian Penal Code read with Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It is an undisputed fact that after registration of the instant case, petitioner was arrested in this case on March 25, 2016 subjected to custodial interrogation and his weapon which was used for the commission of offence, has been recovered. Even the investigation in this case is complete as report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the Court of learned jurisdictional Magistrate, which is still to be committed to the Court of learned Sessions Judge for trial. Moreover,

the parties have already arrived at compromise as is evident from the affidavit of Harkirat Singh-injured as well as that of Malkiat Kaur-complainant.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
