The present petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking the limited relief of transit bail in case FIR No.141 dated 14.08.2015, under Sections 420, 506 read with 34 of Indian Penal Code and 156 (3) of Cr.P.C., registered at Police Station Khammam-III, Telangana.

Counsel would submit that the allegations raised by the complainant are that raw material i.e. cotton worth Rs.7.79 crores approximately was supplied and in lieu thereof the accused/present petitioners had settled dues to the extent of Rs.7.15 crores approximately and a shortfall of Rs.64 lacs approximately is still due.

Prayer made by counsel is for a breather so as to appear and associate in the investigation process as also to approach the competent Court of jurisdiction in the State of Telangana to seek anticipatory bail.

Without touching the merits of the case and keeping in

view the limited prayer raised in the present petition, the same is disposed of by granting to the present petitioners interim bail for a period of 15 days from today. Such indulgence is being shown to enable the petitioners to approach the jurisdictional Court in the State of Telangana to seek remedy of anticipatory bail.

Petition is disposed of.
