Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.722 dated 21.09.2015, registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 469, 471, 120-B and 34 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, learned Additional Advocate General Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. P.S.Jammu, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

learned State counsel and learned counsel for the complainant and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the only allegation against the present petitioner is that she took a SIM of Videocon Company by giving forged identity.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 14.07.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is now not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 14.07.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
