By this petition the petitioner has sought directions to the official respondents to conclude the investigation in a time bound manner in case FIR No.80 dated 30.04.2015, registered under Sections 447, 511, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Sadar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-2) which has been addressed to respondent No.3 and at this stage she would be

satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on her representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3-
The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
