This order shall dispose of CRM-M-23510-2016, filed by
petitioners-Gurpeet Singh @ Ladda and Kulwinder Singh @ Kalu, and
CRM-M-24004-2016, filed by petitioners-Devinder Singh and Bhupinder

**CRM-M-23510-2016 and
CRM-M-24004-2016**

Singh @ Tony, under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.59 dated 21.05.2016, registered at Police Station Banur, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued in both the petitions.

Ms. Shivali, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that only simply injuries have been attributed to the petitioners. Otherwise also, FIR has been registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC.

In pursuance of the interim orders dated 14.07.2016 passed in CRM-M-23510-2016 and dated 21.07.2016 passed in CRM-M-24004-2016 by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are now not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody, I find merit in both the petitions and the same are allowed. The orders dated 14.07.2016 passed in CRM-M-23510-2016 and dated 21.07.2016 passed in CRM-M-24004-2016 by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute.
