The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.133, dated 24.6.2016, registered under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in this case there is alleged recovery of 2 grams of heroin from one co-accused and 80 grams of intoxicating powder from the dash board of the car owned by the second co-accused, and no recovery is from the petitioner at all, and

that co-accused of the petitioner has been granted bail by the trial Court.

In my opinion, this would be no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, this petition is dismissed. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 3.8.2016 and moves an application for regular bail, the trial Court shall decide the same on merits within two days of the filing thereof.
