The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.76 dated 19.05.2016, registered under Sections 307, 365, 336, 342, 323 and 382 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 307, 365 and 382 read with Section 34 IPC deleted subsequently) and Section 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

Heard.

On 14.07.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner is alleged to have fired at the complainant besides beating him.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the offence under Section 307 IPC has been deleted from the FIR and all the offences are bailable except for offence under Section 27 of the Arms Act and that the fire arm alleged to have been used is the licensed weapon of the petitioner.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on July 23, 2016 and August 6, 2016 or any other date as required by the investigating officer and in case of his doing so, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 14.07.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
