This is a petition for anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.22 dated 22.04.2016 under Sections 420/120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

The allegation against the petitioner is that after entering into agreement to sell the land with the complainant the petitioner has mortgaged the land with the bank and then sold it to some body else. Learned counsel has argued that actually the petitioner had obtained loan from the complainant and as security had given blank signed papers which have been misused. He has pointed out that in an earlier inquiry into the same complaint the police had found that it was a case of money dispute. Learned Addl.AG, on instructions from ASI Puran Singh, and learned counsel for the complainant have argued that there was a second inquiry which showed

that the petitioner was guilty.

In my opinion without commenting on the merits of the case the findings of the first inquiry would give a benefit to the petitioner and she should be released on anticipatory bail. Let her appear before the investigating officer on 04.08.2016 between 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. or on any other date on which her presence is required by the investigating officer and on her appearance the investigating officer shall release her on bail subject to the conditions as envisage under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
