JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, preferred by Charanjit Singh, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.1 dated 06.01.2016, under Sections 61 of Excise Act and 420, 465, 468, 471 and 476 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Kotwal Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, Punjab.

Undisputedly, petitioner was arrested in this case on 6th June, 2016 and since then he is suffering incarceration. Investigation is already complete and report under Section 173(2) has already been presented. The disposal of the trial will certainly take sufficient long time. Even otherwise, there is no other case either pending or disposed of against the petitioner of the similar nature.

Taking into consideration all the above-said aspects of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his

furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned
Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
